I'M UNAPOLOGETICALLY MYSELF & I WANT YOU TO BE, TOO



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Why don't digital images come with these packages? The purpose of the Homestead Package is to create timeless, heirloom quality art that is displayed in your home or office for years to come. For that reason, print products are prioritized. Any image selected for print does come with a complimentary social sized digital file of the image for private digital use, not to be used for print reproduction of the image.

When will I see my images and be able to purchase prints? Within two weeks of your session date, you will have a full gallery ready to be purchased from. Digital galleries do have an expiration date of three months from the session date. You will need to make your art selection during that timeframe.

Is there a limit to how many animals you will photograph? For the most part, no! If you have a hundred head of cattle, I obviously cannot guarantee an individual image of each animal, but if you have six horses and would like a variety of photos of each to choose from, that is entirely fine.

Do you have experience around livestock? I sure do! I have attended, participated in, and photographed everything from round ups to brandings to rodeos. ridden horses, sheered alpacas, bottle fed baby lambs, and helped sort wild mustangs. I personally raise over 30 chickens, two 70+ pound dogs, somehow ended up with a pet bunny named Smokey (the joys of having children!), and delivered a litter of kittens. There's not an many animals you're legally allowed to keep that I haven't been around.
